Reminder to hospitality and accommodation providers

In accordance with current Scottish Government COVID 19 requirements, a provisional date of Monday 26th April 2021 has been set for reopening of the tourism and accommodation sector. The Council would like to remind all hospitality and accommodation providers (e.g. hoteliers, B & B, Airbnb, self-catering, camping pods, campsites) that you should remain closed to tourism until this date.

The First Minister has set out how and when current restrictions will be lifted <u>Coronavirus (COVID-19)</u>: <u>timetable for easing restrictions</u>. If you are providing accommodation for non-tourist purposes, you should ensure that you adhere to the exemptions detailed in the <u>COVID Regulations</u> and carry out checks before accepting a new booking or allowing an existing booking to continue prior to the 26th April.
