Whisky & Food festival early 2022 – run together or one at each end.

Working with non-tourism businesses?

All in this together

Re BID – lots of trades don't have premises anymore – no business rates. But they all benefit from or are involved in supporting tourism businesses.

Hard sell to contribute finically if it is voluntary. Needs clear 'whole town' plan for win-win.

BID = Business Information District

Visitor Management

- Better signage to 'off street parking' for motor homes (e.g. retail park or Dornoch South)
- Restrictions (e.g. one hour only) outside shops for greater turnover of cars – no staff parking!
- Designated area at beach for motorhomes (Pay & Display)
