## COVID-19 RESPONSE

Dornoch has a reputation for welcoming visitors, but this year we must do so 'at a distance'. We are sure you will understand that some in our small community are nervous of visitors this year. With a third of our population aged 65 & over, we are especially vulnerable. Everyone must play their part, as we have been doing during lockdown, to protect one another and keep the virus at bay.

Tourism Businesses will

- Follow Scottish Government guidelines
- Implement a Safe Hygiene Policy
- Observe social distancing
- Limit numbers in each outlet
- Show they are ready with the Good to Go symbol



We ask visitors to:

- Only travel if you don't have Covid-19 symptoms
- Observe social distancing (2m in Scotland)
- Wash your hands regularly & carry hand sanitiser with you
- Wear a face covering in shops (mandatory from 10/7/20)
- Avoid busy shops/cafes/restaurants - come back later
- Book your table in advance
- Consider ordering take-aways rather than sitting in

- Pay contactless
- Spend time in our wide open spaces
