

Public Consultation on Dornoch South (ex abattoir site)

For proposed new Golf & Leisure Facility

Monday 14th March 2-8 pm in the Royal Dornoch Golf Clubhouse

We are pleased to announce that earlier this year, Royal Dornoch Golf Club commissioned Halliday Fraser Munro to initiate the planning process to develop a new golf and leisure facility as part of the Dornoch South Masterplan site.

The Dornoch South Masterplan was approved last year, and has acted as a catalyst in the redevelopment of the former abattoir site and adjacent land. The development proposal consists of Leisure Facilities (Principally Golf Related), an Associated Shop and Café (with all Associated Infrastructure and Landscaping Works).

A 'Proposal of Application Notice' (POAN) was submitted on the 15th of February to the Highland Council; this is the first step in the planning process. The next step is to undertake a Pre-Application Public Consultation event, which will be held in the Clubhouse on the 14th of March between 2pm and 8pm. Display materials showing the site and proposed development will be available to view. Scott Leitch, Associate Planning Consultant of Halliday Fraser Munro will also be present to explain the proposals and answer any questions. Attendees will be able to leave comments which will help shape the proposals in further detail before a Planning Application is submitted later this year.
